



Rev. Amos L. Whitman

June 28, 1926 - April 10, 2011

Rev. Amos L. Whitman, of Bowdon, Georgia, passed away on Sunday, April 10, 2011. He was 84.

Rev. Whitman was born on June 28, 1926 in the Hopewell Community of Cleburne County, Alabama to the late Joe and Dula Warren Whitman. He was a U.S. Navy Veteran of WWII where he served in the Pacific Theater aboard the USS Knox. He worked as Sewell's Manufacturing in Bremen and retired from Springs Performance in Calhoun, Georgia. As a minister, Rev. Whitman served as pastor at Etna Baptist, Lee's Chapel Baptist, and East View Baptist in Cedartown, Georgia, North Summerville Baptist and Plainville Baptist in Summerville, Georgia, Second Baptist in Rockmart, Georgia, and Spring Garden Baptist in Piedmont, Alabama. Rev. Whitman was also a 50 year member of Caledonia Lodge No. 121 F&AM in Cedartown, Georgia.

Rev. Whitman is survived by his wife, Elizabeth Whitman; his children and their spouses, Rev. Steve and Susan Whitman and Yvonne and Eddie Gaines; his grandchildren and their spouses, Joey and Cassie Bennett, Brandy Bennett, Heather and Coatney South, Holly Mundy Webb, and Julia and Brian McLeod; his grandchildren, Brittany Bennett, Payton Bennett, Jackson Bennett, Morghann Bennett, Albany Bennett, Haven Bounds, Jack South, Ashton Nelson, Jordan Davis, Hannah South, Ansley Webb, Joseph Webb, Auston McLeod, and Tucker McLeod.
