



## Mrs. Beatrice Brown

Mrs. Mary Beatrice Jackson Brown, of Bowdon, Georgia, passed away on June 9, 2019. She was 89 years old. Although she suffered from dementia, her family still recognized her love for the Lord and love for her family until the very end. She was blessed with unexpected clarity in her final days, which was a gift and comfort to all.

Mrs. Brown was born on July 4, 1929 in Bowdon, Georgia to the late Cliff and Alice Jackson. As a young child, she worked like an adult in the fields picking cotton, pulling fodder, and anything else that had to be done. She graduated from Bowdon High School in 1947 without ever having electricity in her home. She retired from Bremen Bowdon Investments where she worked in the Pants Shop for 42 years. During her lunch hour there, she learned how to crochet and used that skill to make countless baby blankets for expecting mothers. She loved the Lord and enjoyed supporting her church, Mountain View Baptist.

In addition to her parents, Mrs. Brown was preceded in death by her loving husband of 51 years, Carlos Brown; her brothers, James Jackson, John Jackson and Tommy Jackson; and her sisters, Josephine Fletcher, Martha Isaacs, and Jayne Toney.
