



Bee Bee McClung Pullen

July 5, 1948 - May 31, 2018

Mrs. Bee Bee McClung Pullen, of Villa Rica, Georgia, passed away on May 31, 2018. She was 69.

Bee Bee was born on July 5, 1948 in Villa Rica to the late Mercer Elton “Speedy” and June Butler McClung. She was a graduate of Bowdon High School, where she served as her Senior Class President, and of the Grady School of Nursing. Nursing took her to work in many parts of the country including Houston, Lexington, and Shreveport, but she eventually returned to Bowdon and the Bowdon Area Hospital. She worked there till it closed and eventually moved to the Carrollton Eye Clinic. However, in the last few years of nursing was spent at Rapha Clinics in Temple and Bowdon where she help the less fortunate with healthcare. Bee Bee was a generous and kind person who was always willing to help without expecting anything in return. She was selfless with her time and was what many would call “good people.” A rock for her family, she will certainly be missed.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her brother, Randy McClung; her niece, Patty Matthews; and her great-nephew, Hunter Lamon Porter.
