the winter woods. She was a night owl who preferred getting things done in the middle of the

night while everyone else slept. Bessie had an eye for style in her appreciation for decorating,

beautiful landscapes, and antiques. She was proud of her Scotch Irish heritage, and her many

trips to Ireland and Scotland made her feel close to the people, the land and the culture of her ancestors.

She was preceded in death by her husband, George Burton Coley, and grandson, Adam L. Coley.
