Mr. Bob Butler, of Graham, Alabama, passed away on Monday, March 21, 2011. He was 84.

Mr. Butler was born on October 1, 1926 in Graham to the late Loyd and Sadie Huckabee Butler. He was a veteran of the U.S. Army and worked as a farmer. He was a member of Old Harmony Primitive Baptist Church.
