Mr. Brandon Kyle Smith, of Bowdon, Georgia, was taken from this walk of life suddenly on Thursday, February 6th, 2020. He was 39.

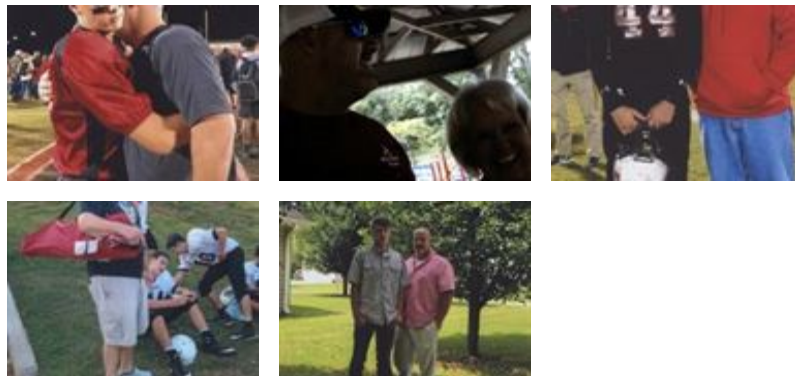

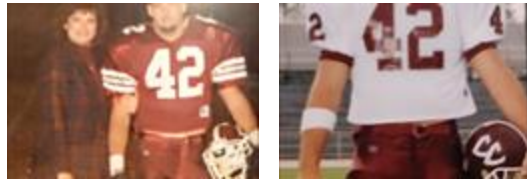

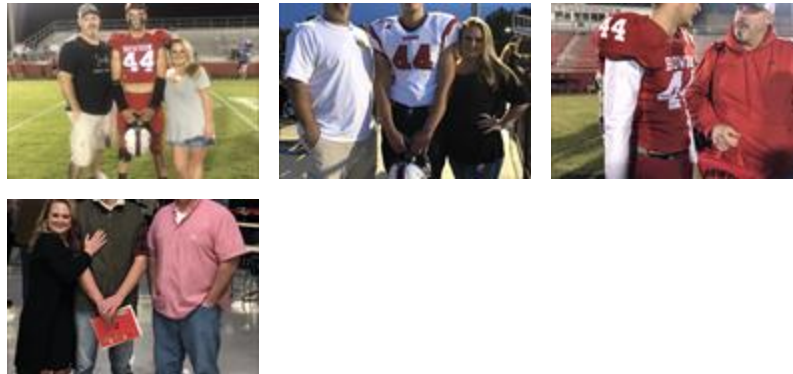
