



## Mrs. Carol Witt Ozier

September 24, 1946 - September 10, 2018

Carol Lynn Witt Ozier of Carrollton died on September 10th after an illness.

Carol was born on September 24, 1946 in Bowdon, Georgia, daughter of the late Jones Loxman and Madian Turner Witt. In addition to her parents, she is preceded in death by her younger sister, Jane Mackey Witt.

Carol graduated from Bowdon High School, and what was then West Georgia College. Upon completing her degree in French language, she enlisted as an intelligence officer in the 3902 AirBase Wing 12th RTS SAC of the United States Air Force. Eventually promoted to a Captain, Carol served for nearly 5 years in stations in Colorado Springs, Omaha, and Tan Son Nhut Air Base in Saigon, Vietnam. Upon returning to Bowdon, she owned a flower shop, served as a US Postal Service carrier, and eventually retired as a State Farm Insurance agent, while co-owning and operating the family business, Ozier Products (now Ozier Apparel).

Carol was active in her community. She was a member of Carroll County Master Gardeners, Little Tallapoosa Botanical Society, Bowdon Garden Club, and the Davis-Digby Women's Circle of the Bowdon First United Methodist Church. Carol also served as president of the Carrollton High School Athletic Booster Club and the Bowdon Sertoma Club.

To those who knew her, Carol was an avid reader and adventurous traveler. In addition to serving overseas, and seeing nearly all 50 states, she visited Thailand, Hong Kong, Egypt, criss-crossed Europe, traversed China by train, and sailed through the Panama Canal.

Carol is survived by her husband of 40 years, William Robert (Billy) Ozier, and four sons: William (Will) Copeland Ozier, Luke Turner Ozier, Mark Roop Ozier, all of Carrollton, and Lance Witt Ozier of New York City; a daughter-in-law, Angelika Kersman Ozier, and two grandchildren, Copeland Alexander and Anya Madian Ozier all of Carrollton; and three first cousins: James (Jim) Witt of Bowdon, and Leslie Witt Gates and Jennifer Witt Burns of Atlanta.

Carol donated her body to Emory University Medical School, and a service will be held on Sunday, September 16th in The Old Train Depot at 455 Bradley Street in Carrollton. Family will begin greeting guests at 1:30 pm with a memorial service at 2:00 pm and refreshments to follow.
