



Mr. Chuck Huey

March 9, 1956 - June 22, 2018

Charles David “Chuck” Huey, of Bowdon, Georgia, passed away on June 22, 2018. He was 62.

Mr. Huey was born on March 9, 1956 in Bowdon to Johnnie B. and Edna Pace Huey. He graduated Bowdon High School in 1974 and then attended Gainesville Junior College and West Georgia College. He worked at Bremen-Bowdon Investment and Lamar Manufacturing for a time, but had worked for the U.S. Postal service since 1995 and made many friends while working there. He also was a cattle farmer, a job that he shared with his father, and always prepared a large garden from which he cooked and canned. He was an outdoorsman and enjoyed hunting and fishing and had many trophy mounts. Mr. Huey was an avid sports enthusiast and was especially a fan of the University of West Georgia and Auburn University’s football teams. One of his favorite players, Dontavious Russell lived on his mail route.

He is survived by his parents, Johnnie B. and Edna Huey of Bowdon; his brother, Mike (Katy) Huey of Los Angeles, California; his step-children, Christy Talley Smith (Rob) and Hope Talley Szczepkowski (Joe), all of Carrollton, and Andy Talley of Atlanta; his aunts and uncles, Lavy Sheffield, Charles Glenn, and June Pace; 7 grandchildren whom he dearly loved, one special God child; numerous cousins; and special friends, Travis and Lutrena Hill and Doyle and Rebecca Akins.

Funeral services will be held on Sunday, June 24, 2018 at 3:00 p.m. at Bowdon First United Methodist Church. Dr. James Street and Bro. Randy

Simpkins will officiate. Mr. Doyle Akins will offer a eulogy and Karen Vance will provide the music. Pallbearers will be Travis Hill, Lavy Sheffield, Larry Beam, Same Belew, Mike Dixon, and Jim Chaffin. Honorary pallbearers will be Mr. Huey's friends and coworkers from the US Postal Service. Interment will follow in the church cemetery.


