



Mr. Clint Steed

September 1, 1930 - November 17, 2020

Mr. Roy Clinton “Clint” Steed, of Bowdon, Georgia, passed away on November 17, 2020 after a brief illness. He was 90.

Mr. Steed was born on September 1, 1930 in Burwell, Georgia to the late Ralph Alston and Eula Rampy Steed. He grew up in the Tyus community and graduated from Bowdon High School in 1947. Shortly after graduation, Mr. Steed joined the U.S. Navy where he proudly served aboard the aircraft carrier U.S.S. Boxer from 1947 to 1951. In 1950, he married Floy “Tootsie” Rowland.

For many years Mr. Steed was the owner of Steed Trucking Company in Bowdon, Georgia and, after his retirement, worked for several years as a bus driver for Carroll County Schools. He loved gardening and taking care of his yard. Even in his late 80’s it was common to see him once or twice a week mowing his lawn or riding his tractor in the back yard when it was time to plan a corn crop.

Mr. Steed was a longtime member of Bowdon Baptist Church where he served as a deacon. Those who knew him best knew he was a man with a great sense of humor and a love of conversation. He believed in the value of hard work, honest, and the importance of family.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife of 67 years, Floy Steed; his brother, Bill Steed; and a grandchild, Kelly Foster.

Survivors include his daughter and son-in-law, Gail and Buddy Foster of Carrollton, Georgia; his son and daughter-in-law, Matt and Lyn Steed of Wedowee, Alabama; his sister, Barbara Smith of Ridgefield, Connecticut; his three grandchildren, Elijah Steed, Zach Steed, and Kalin Steed; a special nephew who he often said was like a brother to him, Jim Steed of Lafayette, Alabama; and many cousins, nieces, and nephews.

A private graveside service was conducted for Mr. Steed on Friday, November 20, 2020 at Bowdon City Cemetery.
