Mr. Karry Curtis Lovvorn, of Bowdon, Georgia, passed away on February 27, 2012. He was 85.

Mr. Lovvorn was born on August 19, 1926 in Bowdon to the late George and Maud Kemp Lovvorn. He was retired from the U.S. Postal Service where he worked for 30 years as a Rural Letter Carrier. Not only did he deliver the mail, but also left gum and candy in the boxes for the kids that lived on his route.
