January 14, 1945 - January 12, 2025

Mr. David Lindon Noles, known to many as Pete, Red, DL, and Pops, of Ranburne, Alabama passed away on Sunday, January 12, 2025. He would have been 80 on January 14.

Mr. Noles was born on January 14, 1945 in Graham, Alabama to David Beason and Hazel Cosper Noles. He worked with his parents as owners of DB Noles & Son Grocery and Laundromat in Bowdon, Georgia. He left the store business and operated poultry houses for Gold Kist and Koch's. After the poultry houses, his greatest joy was helping his son, Shane, operate Peachstate Wrestling Alliance. PWA operated in Heflin, Villa Rica, Bremen and the Carrollton Fairgrounds. He loved meeting and talking with the wrestling fans and he always had a story to tell. He loved watching the Oakland/Las Vegas Raiders, the Boston Celtics and the Chicago Cubs. He was preceded in death by his parents, Beason & Hazel Noles; his mother-in-law, Wilma Stephens; and his brother-in-law, Terry Stephens.

He is survived by his son, Shane Noles; his ex-wife, Charlotte Noles; his sister, Jimmie Ruth (Fred) McLeod; his nephew, Dr. Tony (Jennifer) McLeod; his niece, Leslie (Rob) Riley; several great-nieces and nephews; his brother-in-law, Ricky (Donna) Stephens; and a great friend, Merlyn Ward.

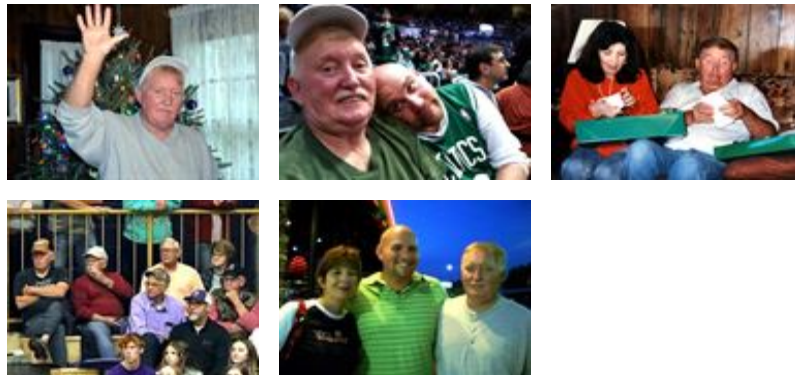
