Mr. Dewey Edward Gibbs, of Ranburne, Alabama, passed away on October 2, 2014. He was 95.

Mr. Gibbs was born on May 30, 1919 to the late Dewey and Donie Langley Gibbs. He was a U.S. Army veteran of World War II. Mr. Gibbs was a life-long cattle farmer and opened Gibbs Feed and Poultry in Heflin, Alabama in 1953. He was instrumental in the proposal and building of Lost Creek watersheds, served on the Board of Directors for the Bank of Heflin, and helped establish the broiler and hen business in Cleburne and surrounding counties. But, to his family, he'll be remembered as a loving husband, father, and grandfather.

In addition to her parents, he was preceded in death by his wife, Loice Gibbs; his brother, Clyde Gibbs; and his sister, Macy York.
