Mrs. Doris Eris Jackson Rogers, age 83, of Harvell Drive (formerly Reavesville Road), Bowdon, Georgia died Wednesday, September 7, 2016 after a brief illness. Mrs. Rogers was born on February 28, 1933 in Heard County to the late Roy Norman Jackson, Sr. and Annie Lou Eidson Jackson. She was a retired seamstress.

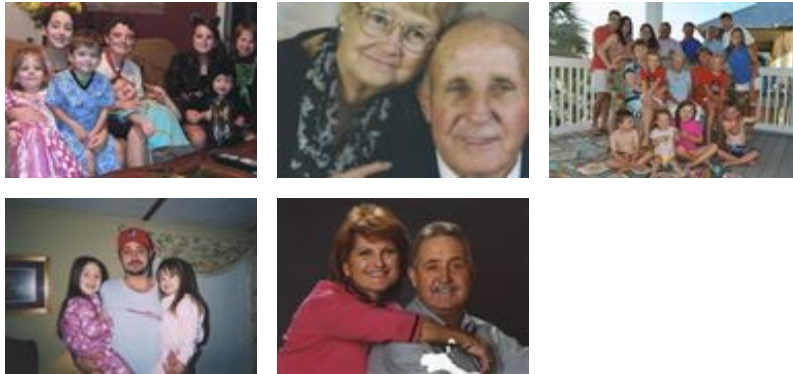
