Mr. Robert Doyl Grainger, of the Farmer's High community in Carrollton, Georgia, passed away on Sunday, December 5, 2010. He was 82.

Mr. Grainger was born on June 16, 1928 in Carroll County, Georgia to the late Robert and Mattie Johnson Grainger. He was a veteran of the U.S. Army and served in the Korean Conflict. Mr. Grainger was also a self-employed contractor and a member of Tyus Baptist Church.
