August 8, 1924 - March 7, 2025

Mrs. Edna Pace Huey entered this life on August 8, 1924 in Center, Georgia. On the quiet, serene morning of March 7, 2025, God called her to her heavenly home. She was the eleventh child of John Pat and Ida Collins Pace. Edna had six sisters, Lillie Mae Thornton, Darlene Wills, Johnnie Sue Panian, Nina White, Vivian Jones, and Nellie Adams; and four brothers, Raymond Pace, Eusil Pace, Clayton Pace, and Earl Pace. They all preceded her in death.

Edna was educated in the Benton School in Jackson County, Georgia. She attended Young Harris College in Young Harris, Georgia and the University of West Georgia in Carrollton. She was a retired teacher with the Carroll County School System. Over the course of her career, she worked at Burwell, Mt. Zion, and Bowdon Elementary School. She grew up in a Christian home and was an active and faithful member of Bowdon First Methodist Church. Edna's faith never failed her and "God Provided" all that she needed to finish her journey in this life. The Lord loved her and she loved Him.

Edna had such a loving heart for her family, friends, neighbors, community and church. She loved children and encouraged them to be the best they could be. She and her husband, Johnnie, provided scholarships to support children who needed a helping hand.
