



Mr Frank T. Lane

November 1, 1932 - July 21, 2011

Mr. Frank T. Lane, of Carrollton, Georgia, passed away Thursday, July 21, 2011. He was 78.

Mr. Lane was born on November 1, 1932 in Carroll County, Georgia to the late M.B. Lane, Sr. and Ann Meigs Lane. He was employed by Georgia Deer Farm, and a member of Bowdon Baptist Church in Bowdon, Georgia and a veteran of the U.S. Army stationed at Fort Bliss, Texas. Frank graduated from Bowdon High School in 1949. He managed Polled Hereford Cattle farms in Carroll, Upson, and Colquitt counties, and his own cattle farm in the Farmers' High community. Frank served as president of both the Georgia Cattlemen's Association and the Carroll County Cattlemen's Association. He also served on Carroll County School Board as well as on the Board of the local sales barn. Frank coached little league baseball in Carroll and Upson counties. One of his favorite pastimes was watching his grandsons play baseball.

In addition to his parents, Mr. Lane was preceded in death by a son, Frank T. lane, Jr. and his brother Horace Lane.

Survivors include his wife Jackie Gray Lane, to whom he was married on May 4, 1957; sons and daughters-in-law Russ and Karen Lane, Jess and Gayle Lane, Paul and Sherry Lane, and Luke and Jennifer Lane; grandchildren Hayley, Jacob, Jared, Jena, Austin, Ashleigh, Kyleigh, Riley, and Camden

Lane. He was also survived by one brother, M.B. Lane, Jr., and two sisters; Mrs. Anne O'Quinn and Mrs. Janie Baxter.

Funeral services for Mr. Frank Lane will be conducted on Sunday, July 24, 2011 at 3:00 p.m. at Bowdon Baptist Church in Bowdon, Georgia. He will be placed in state at the church at 2:00 p.m. Dr. Ron Huggins, Dr. Howard Cobble, and Rev. Luke Lane will officiate. Music will be provided by Gayle Lane and Jared Lane. Mr. Jerry Searcy, Mr. Larry Lane, Mr. Doug Gray, Mr. Mills Lane, Mr. James O'Quinn and Mr. Jeff Barr will serve as Pallbearers. The Winson Sunday School Class will serve as honorary Pallbearers. Interment services will follow in the Antioch Baptist Church Cemetery, Carrollton, GA.
