Fred Traylor, of Bowdon, Georgia, died on October 16, 2022 after several months of declining health.

Fred was born on September 24, 1935 in Newell, Alabama to the late Wade and Gladys Lovvorn Traylor. Fred was a retired cattle farmer and worked at Trent Tube for a number of years.
