



Mr. Horace Ray Garrett

March 28, 1943 - October 7, 2013

Mr. Horace Ray Garrett, of Bowdon, Georgia, passed away on October 7, 2013. He was 70.

Ray was born in Bowdon on March 28, 1943 to the late Horace Glenn and Clarice Copeland Garrett. He graduated from Bowdon High School in 1961. He attended the Hartford School of Insurance and worked at Carroll Realty and Insurance and retired from American General Insurance. Ray also attended Georgia State University and, while there, worked at The Varsity in Atlanta.

Ray was an entertainer at heart. As a young child he would dress in a top hat, tails, and a cane and entertain the Ladies Club of Bowdon by reciting Mother Goose tales. He was a member of the Jaycees and did public speaking which led him to become 'the Voice of the Bowdon Red Devils.' He held this honor for 33 years before his failing health ended his career in 2012.

After his retirement from American General, Ray worked as a Bailiff for the Carroll County Sheriff's Department. Always a community servant, he served as a Bowdon City Councilman for 12 years and was a founding member of the Bowdon Area Hospital Authority.

Ray was a lifelong member of the First United Methodist Church of Bowdon.

He loved to play golf, to fish, cooking, and playing cards. He loved the Bowdon Red Devils, the Georgia Bulldogs football, and the citizens of Bowdon. He was a true example of "The Friendly City."

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by the mother of his children Joy Lanier Garrett; his brother Harold Garrett and his daughter Laura Garrett Bailey.

Survivors include his wife of 26 years Kathy Turner-Garrett; his children Debbie Garrett Smith (Jeff), Alan Garrett (Suzanne), Andy Garrett and Chris Turner (Brandi); his grandchildren Brandon Garrett, Allison Smith Robinson, Anna Smith Albright, Drew, Mallory and Leah Garrett, Morgan Turner Jones, Savannah and Iven Ross Turner; great-grandchildren Kaide Garrett, Brantley Jones and Claire Robinson; caregivers Louise Holland, Jacque Benefield and Darlene Freeman.

Services for Mr. Garrett will be held on Wednesday, October 9, 2013 at 4:00 pm at Bowdon United Methodist Church with Rev. Randy Mickler officiating and a Eulogy from Mr. Mike Steed.
