Mr. Johnnie A. "Junior" Harris, age 89, of Ranburne, Alabama, passed away on Saturday, July 11, 2015.

Mr. Harris was born on June 26, 1926 in Cleburne County, Alabama to the late Johnnie and Emma Harris. He was a dedicated husband, father, grandfather and friend. He was a Seaman First Class in the U.S. Navy from 1944 till 1946.
