



## Mr. James Randall Buchanan

May 13, 1930 - July 4, 2010

Mr. James Randall Buchanan, of Carrollton, Georgia, passed away on Sunday, July 4, 2010. He was 80.

Mr. Buchanan was born on May 13, 1930 in Cleburne County, Alabama to the late Johnny and Mildred Pope Buchanan. He was a veteran of the U.S. Army having served stateside during the Korean Conflict.
