He loved talking about his first wagon ride to Carrollton and all the trouble he stirred up as a boy, from foot races and scuffles, he grew up in a time where you had to make it in on your own and he kept that mentality his whole life, working until he was in his late eighties. He was loved and admired by many as he was one of a kind. He was preceded in death by his parents; his wife, Doris Wheeler; his son, Chuck Wheeler; his grandson Colt Wheeler; and his granddaughter Starla Wheeler. He was also preceded by his siblings, Inez Myers, Diane White, and Melissa Robinson.
