In Loving Memory

July 17, 1925 – July 8, 2015

James “Grady” Gamble, 89, went to be with our Lord on Wednesday, July 8th, 2015. He follows his wife Betty Jean Gamble who went to be with our Lord December 1st, 2014. He is survived by his daughter Jeannie Christine Gamble, his son James Grady Gamble Jr. and his daughter-in-law Julia Ann Gamble.

Grady was born in Bowdon, Georgia to Emma Lou Gamble nee Huie and William Judson Gamble. He graduated from Bowdon High School in 1942 and enlisted in the United States Army. He served as a Forward Observer in the 75th Infantry Division. He was awarded the Bronze Star for valor in combat during the Battle of the Ardennes where he distinguished himself as a courageous soldier. He fought bravely in the Battle of the Bulge and helped the allies bring WWII to a close. He returned to Bowdon in 1946.

Grady worked for 37 years as a line supervisor for AT&T in Atlanta, Georgia where he resided. He was a lifelong member of the Telephone Pioneers. He was a member of Dunwoody United Methodist Church. He was a loving

husband and father. He was a good friend and neighbor to many. He will be laid to rest at Bowdon City Cemetery after a visitation beginning at 12:00 pm (Georgia Time) and memorial service beginning at 1:00 pm (Georgia Time) at Rainwater Funeral Home in Bowdon, Georgia Saturday, July 11, 2015.

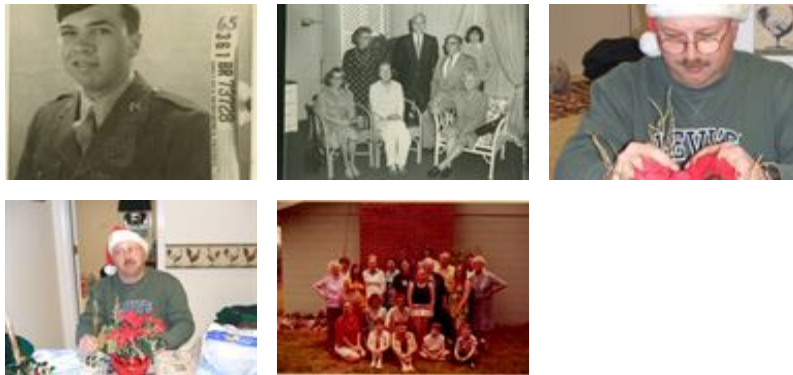
