Dr. James L. "Jim" Agan, of Carrollton, Georgia, passed away on January 25, 2025. He was 77.

Jim was born on December 3, 1947 in Atlanta, Georgia to the late Leslie James "L.J." and Willie Agan. After graduating from Paulding County High School, he served in the U.S. Army where he worked in a support role during the Vietnam War. After his military service concluded, he began the life of a public servant as an educator and elected official. He gained degrees in Education at West Georgia, Shorter, and Berry before ultimately obtaining his doctorate degree from Auburn University in 1989. His career in education culminated with his retirement from the University of West Georgia as the Director of Continuing Education. As a civil servant, he was elected to be on the City Council and eventually Mayor of the city of Bowdon. In his spare time, he enjoyed playing golf, watching Auburn football, and playing with his grandkids.
