Charlie Jean Kidd Steed (Jeanie), 89, of The Oaks of Carrollton and formerly of Bowdon, died Saturday, June 24, 2017.

Mrs. Steed was born in Heard County, Georgia on April 29, 1928, the daughter of the late Charlie Aubrey Kidd and Pauline Yarbrough Kidd.

She grew up in Carrollton, Georgia, attending Carrollton City Schools, and graduated from Carrollton High School in 1945. She married Hal Irvin Steed on June 5, 1949, at Tabernacle Baptist Church.

Mrs. Steed worked as the utilities clerk at the City of Bowdon Water Department until retirement and was a mother of four sons. She was a long-term active member of Bowdon Baptist Church. 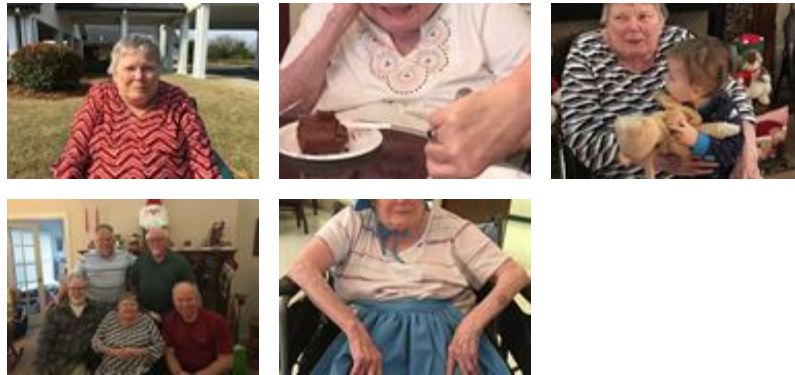
