



Coach Jeff Herren

November 19, 1965 - August 4, 2020

Thomas Jeffrey “Jeff” Herren, of Bowdon, Georgia, passed away on August 4, 2020. He was 54.

Jeff was born on November 19, 1965 in Carrollton, Georgia to Thomas Jerry and Margaret Herren. He was a graduate of Woodland High School and Jacksonville State University. He taught math and coached football for 30 years at Bowdon High School. When he retired, he was the Defensive Coordinator. While at Bowdon, he helped coach teams that won many region championships, made several appearances in the state finals and semi-finals, and won the 1992 Class A State Championship. He was a positive role model and mentor to countless young men over the course of his career. Upon his retirement, the football program established the Jeff Herren Loyalty Award to honor his career-long commitment to Bowdon High School and its student-athletes.

In addition to his parents, Jerry and Margaret Herren, he is survived by his wife, Sandra Herren; his siblings and their spouses, Kim and Mike McCain and Mark and Tammie Herren; his step-children, Nina Parmer, Julie Parmer, and Chip Ballenger and his wife, Sabrina; his grandchildren, Iesha Towns, Cord Parmer, Dee Hammett, Chelzie Parmer, Dalton Ballenger, Emmet Ballenger, and Britton Ballenger; his great-grandchildren, Kameron Parmer, Kamoni Towns, Peyton Parmer, Aurora Parmer, and Ariel Parmer; and his nephew, Spencer McCain.
