Mrs. Judy Prather Bivins, of Anniston, Alabama and formerly of Bowdon, passed away on October 23, 2024. She was 72.

Mrs. Bivins was born on December 28, 1950 in Columbus, Georgia to the late Albert Wade Prather, Jr. and Gladys Chambers Prather. She was a 1969 graduate of Mount Zion High School where she was voted Miss Mount Zions, served as a class officer, was captain of the basketball team, and was voted “wittiest” in the senior class. In 1970, she married Lyle Bivins. She was an administrative assistant for many years to the Dean of the College of Education at West Georgia College and later helped to manage operations at the Calhoun County Courthouse in Anniston.

She was also a devout Christian and maintained a personal ministry of serving those in need by donating food and clothing to the homeless and low-income families.

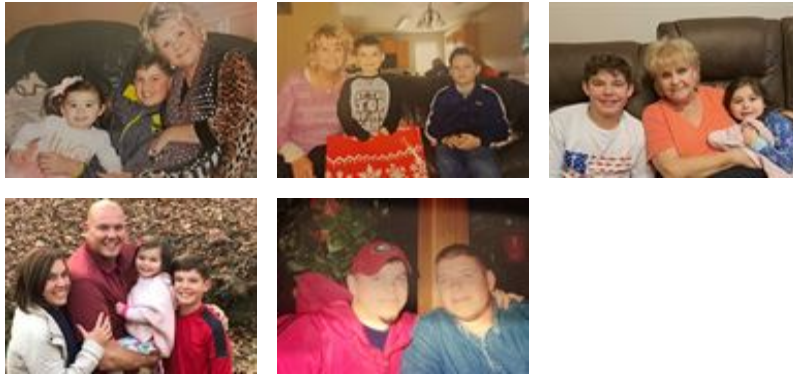
