Kimberly Gresham Wysoczynski, of Bowdon, passed away on Friday, October 1, 2010. She was 49.

Mrs. Wysoczynski was born on May 2, 1961 the daughter of the late Dr. Walter S. and Susan Jean Gresham. She was a member of Our Lady of Perpetual Help Catholic Church in Carrollton and worked as a nurse at the Southwire Medical Center. She was also a member of the Bowdon Area Historical Society. Mrs. Wysoczynski loved her family, her friends, and all of the patients she cared for in over 28 years of working in healthcare. She loved pets and was a friend to all animals.

In addition to her parents, Mrs. Wysoczynski was preceded in death by her sister, Karen Gresham, and her grandfather and grandmother, Walter Quinton and Jessie Hale Gresham.

She is survived by her loving husband, Gerald Wysoczynski; her children, Gerald Wysoczynski, Jr. of Carrollton, Georgia and Christina Leigh Wysoczynski of Denver, Colorado; her brother, Walter S. Gresham, Jr. and his wife, Maureen, of Boise, Idaho; and her sister, Cynthia Balazs and her husband, Roy, of Chicago, Illinois.

Funeral services for Kimberly Gresham Wysoczynski will be held on Monday,

October 4, 2010 at 2:00 p.m. at Our Lady of Perpetual Help in Carrollton. Father Raphael Carballo and Deacon Gary Atkinson will officiate. Dan Williamson and Tom Miller will offer eulogies and Amy Wilson will provide the music. Tom Miller, Dan Williamson, Mike Meder, Tom Wysoczynski, Adam Szwec, and Trey Fleck will serve as pallbearers. Honorary pallbearers will be Donald Wysoczynski, Gerald Wysoczynski, Jr., Jim Wysoczynski, and her coworkers from the Southwire Medical Center. Interment will follow the services at Bowdon City Cemetery.

The family will receive friends at the funeral home on Sunday, October 3rd from 5:00 until 8:00 p.m.

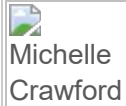

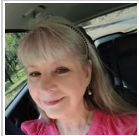
