Larry Nelson Ross, of Carrollton, Georgia, passed away on Tuesday, January 18, 2011. He was 62.

Mr. Ross was born on May 28, 1948 in Zebulon, Georgia to the late Leavy Edward and Fannie Nelson Ross. He was retired from the Georgia Department of Natural Resources Wildlife Division after 34 years of service. He also enjoyed woodworking and bird watching.
