March 27, 1936 - November 21, 2010

Mr. Leonard Robinson, Jr., of Carrollton, Georgia, passed away on Sunday, November 21, 2010. He was 74.

Mr. Robinson was born on March 27, 1936 in Cleburne County, Alabama to Leonard Robinson, Sr. and Mildred Parrish Robinson. He was a U.S. Army veteran and worked locally in law enforcement with the Tallapoosa Police Department and the Cleburne County Sherriff's Department. He also served as the Carroll County Constable. Mr. Robinson also enjoyed writing and had his book, "Trying Times," published. He was of the Primitive Baptist faith.

He was preceded in death by his father, Leonard Robinson, Sr., and two nieces and nephews.

Survivors include his mother, Mildred Robinson; his brothers and sisters-in-law, Bobby Robinson, Donnie and Mary Robinson, and Ted and Nadine Robinson; his sisters and brothers-in-law, Mernette and Fred Hicks, Carolyn and Jimmy Cook, Melinda and Terry Cook, and Jan and Charles Rosson; 14 nieces and nephews, and many great-nieces and nephews.

Fuenral services for Mr. Robinson will be held on Wednesday, November 24, 2010 at 3:00 p.m. at Poplar Springs Primitive Baptist Church. Elder Leonard Robinson and Elder Dave Chandler will officiate. Mr. Robinson's nephews will

serve as pallbearers. Interment will follow at the church cemetery.

Prior to the services, Mr. Robinson's body will lie-in-state at the church from 2:00 p.m. until the funeral hour.
