



Mrs. Linda Copeland Green

May 22, 1936 - June 28, 2025

Linda Copeland Green, 89, passed away Saturday, June 28th, at Carrollton Manor Assisted Living Facility, a resident for the past four years.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband, Travis Green; daughter, Patricia Ann; brothers, Otis, Cecil, Dan, Robbie, and W.A. Copeland; and sister, Lucy White. She is survived by her two sons Richard Green of Bowdon and Jimmy (Shelley) Green of Mount Zion; grandchildren Jessica Kytte, Jacob (Angelica) Green, and Hannah Green; great grandchildren Josiah Green, Jameson Green, and Rita Green; and sisters Virginia (Dwain) Geter of Roopville, and Martha Pierce of Burwell; and many nieces and nephews.

Linda was born May 22, 1936, in Bowdon to George Henderson and Grace Rooks Copeland and raised on a farm in the Burwell Community. She was the third oldest of 5 brothers and 3 sisters and helped raise her younger siblings. She graduated from Bowdon High School in 1954 and worked as a bookkeeper for various companies, but most of her career was spent at Roop Wholesale in Bowdon.

She was married June 30th, 1961, to Travis Green at Shiloh Church in Burwell. They lived in Woodland, Bremen, and finally settled in Bowdon in 1965. They were longtime members of the Bowdon First Methodist Church.

Linda loved gardening, reading, putting together jigsaw puzzles, and tackling puzzle books.

A passage from the obituary of Linda's grandmother, Alice Kate Upchurch Copeland, written by V.D. Whaley in 1942, fits Linda perfectly, who "...never sought publicity. She was content to be a good mother and wife and humble follower of her Lord. Her home and her church meant everything to her. She loved and lived the quiet and peaceful and trustful life. She lived her religion and said little about it. The great doctrines of Grace and Faith and Love were dear to her heart. The world needs such servants. The church needs them. The homes need them. Such mothers make a wealth of contribution to the cause of Christianity that words cannot measure. After all, example and influence are stars that never grow dim. Mother's teachings, in the old childhood home, profoundly affect the loves and destiny of the children. Homes built on Faith and Love are like diamonds that never lose their sparkle. Such homes are akin to heavenly mansions. And such homes filled with material care and prayer and contentment and happiness, are the very citadels of civilization and the dreams of the ages. Life, at its best, blooms and fruitions in such an environment..."

Funeral services will be held on Wednesday, July 2, 2025 at 2:00 p.m. at Bowdon First Methodist Church. Rev. Kevin Geter will officiate. Interment will follow at Bowdon City Cemetery.

Prior to the services, the family will receive friends at the church from 12:00 till the funeral hour.

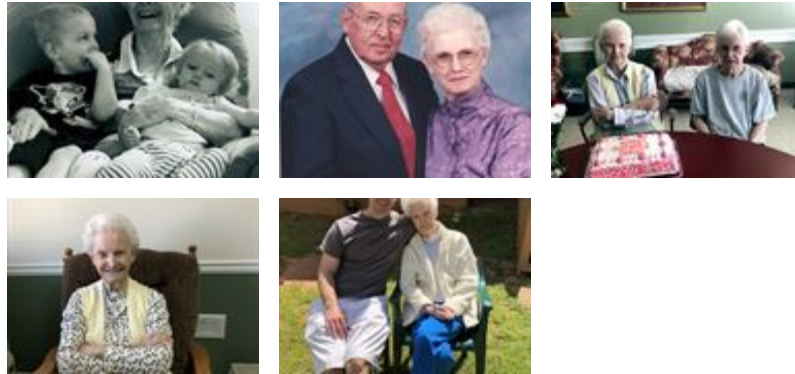
