Lloyd "Buck" Howell, of Bowdon, Georgia, passed away on April 18, 2016. He was 76.

Mr. Howell was born on July 16, 1939 in Manatee County, Florida. He was retired from the Florida Department of Corrections and worked at the Hillsborough Correctional Institution. While at Hillsborough, he was promoted to Sergeant and was recognized for saving the state over \$100,000 for his work in securing donations for items needed at the prison.

He was preceded in death by his mother and step-father, Jewell and Marion Howell; his father, Jesse Parrish; and his brother, Larry Parrish, and his step-mother, Hope Parrish.

Survivors include his wife, Harriet Bigelow Howell; his children, Darilyn (Kevin) Bodie, Larry Howell, and Mark Howell; his step-daughter, Cynthia (Bob) Stevens; his grandchildren, Shawn Bodie, Corey Bodie, Stephannie Howell, and Jessica Howell; and his sisters, Arlen Hicks and Kay Thompson.
