Mr. Lunie L. Preston, of Bowdon, Georgia, passed away on Tuesday, January 4, 2011. He was 93.

Mr. Preston was born on May 21, 1917 in Cleburne County, Alabama to the late James Samuel and Alice Langley Preston. He retired from the piano and music sales business in 1971 and was a member of Indian Creek Baptist Church.
