A big man with a big heart, Mark A. Mabry, of Carrollton, age 62, made his transition from time to eternity on January 20, 2023 at Tanner Medical Center after an extended illness.

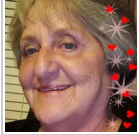

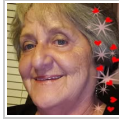
