



Mr. Max Moore

August 8, 1937 - January 30, 2012

Mr. Max Kaylor Moore, of Carrollton, Georgia, passed away on January 30, 2012. He was 74.

Mr. Moore was born on August 8, 1937 in the Dot Community of Carroll County, Georgia to the late Joy and Mary Susan Cospers Moore. He graduated from Bowdon High School in 1956 and attended Berry College until joining the U.S. Army. In the Army, he received advanced training at the Army Tank Training Center in Ft. Knox, Kentucky and was a tank commander in the 2nd Army 11th Armored Cavalry Regiment 1st Battalion Tank Company in Straubing, Germany. After his discharge, Mr. Moore returned to west Georgia and began working at Warren Sewell Clothing Company in Bremen. In 1967 he went to work for the Plantation Pipeline Company. While working for Plantation, Mr. Moore moved to Louisiana for many years and then returned to work in their Austell office in logistical operations. He retired in 2004 after 37 years of service. In his retirement, Mr. Moore enjoyed shooting pool and working on the family farm, but he most enjoyed riding his motorcycle. With his friends, he toured much of the United States and many of the national parks. He was especially fond of the west and the Rocky Mountains.

He is survived by his wife, Sandra Turner Moore; his son, Michael John Moore and his fiancée, Amy Creasman, of Carrollton; his brother and sister-in-law, Larry James and Susan Moore of Buchanan, GA; his niece, Annette Joy

Jackson and her husband, Henry, of Griffin, GA; his nephew, Anthony James Moore and his wife, Julie, of Bremen, GA; and one great-niece and two great-nephews.

Funeral services will be held on Thursday, February 2, 2012 at 3:00 p.m. at the Chapel of Rainwater Funeral Home. Rev. Byron Spruill will officiate.
