



Mr. Miller Norrell

Mr. Miller B. Norrell, of Ranburne, Alabama, passed away on Thursday, June 6, 2013. He was 98.

Mr. Miller was born in Conyers, Georgia on August 14, 1914 to the late M.B. Norwell, Sr. and Mary Ann Norwell. He was the last of 9 siblings to be with the Lord.

“Mr. Miller,” as he was well known, was a life long resident of Cleburne County, Alabama, living most of his life (98 years) in the Gold Ridge/Ranburne community. He touched many lives in that community and surrounding areas through his trust, worthiness, in his carpentry skills and his church work. Most people knew him for his knowledge of carpentry, quick wit, laugh and ready smile. He was the oldest chartered member of Crumley’s Chapel Church of God, where he was a member for over 60 years and served as a teacher and clerk. Always ready to lend a hand in help with building or repairs of the church or parsonage.

In addition to his parents and siblings, he was preceded in death by his wife of 57 years, Hattie Mae Otwell Norwell.

Survivors include in six children, Odis Norwell, Betty Benefield, Dixie Lowery, and Elaine Hyatt, all of Ranburne, Alabama, Joan Collins of North Carolina, and Judy Ramsey of South Carolina. He was blessed with 14 Grandchildren, 18 great-grandchildren and 8 great-great grandchildren. Mr. Norwell lived a long and dedicated life to his family and church. He will be greatly missed by all who know him.

Funeral services will be held on Saturday, June 8, 2012 at 2 p.m. EST at Crumley’s Chapel Church of God with Rev. Duran Teague and Rev. Tony Mahathy officiating.
