



Rev. Monroe Wiggins

September 26, 1923 - February 22, 2010

Rev. Monroe Wiggins, of Bowdon, Georgia, passed away on Monday, February 22, 2010. He was 86.

Rev. Wiggins was born on September 26, 1923 to the late Ucal and Annie Mae Jordan Wiggins. He was widely known and respected in Georgia and Alabama as a minister of the gospel and served 19 churches throughout his lifetime. During his ministry, his home church remained Pleasant Grove Baptist Church.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his daughter and son-in-law, Christa and Jerry Wayne Clines; his grandson, Spencer Wiggins; his brothers, Lee Otis, Curtis, Aron, Lewis, George, and Herbert Wiggins; and his sisters, Josie Wysner and Wilma Spruill.

Survivors include his wife, Louise Freeman Wiggins; his son and daughter-in-law, Wayne and Mildred Wiggins; his daughter, Gwendolyn Griffin; his siblings and their spouses, Mary and Don Moore of Bremen, Margaret and Hobart Rampey of Woodland, and Videra Brown of Bowdon; 9 grandchildren and 11 great-grandchildren.

Funeral services for Rev. Monroe Wiggins will be held on Wednesday, February 24, 2010 at 2:00 p.m. at Sardis Baptist Church. Rev. Darnell Teal, Rev. Winford Spruill, and Rev. Jerry Wiggins will officiate. Pallbearers will be Chris Clines, Michael Wiggins, Rob Griffin, Scott Young, John Giffin, and Darrell Hand. Interment will follow in the church cemetery. Prior to the funeral services, Rev. Wiggins' body will lie-in-state at the church from 1:00 p.m. until the funeral hour.
