Mrs. Muriel Sue McIntosh Miles of Carrollton, Georgia passed away on Saturday, August 15, 2015. She was 72.

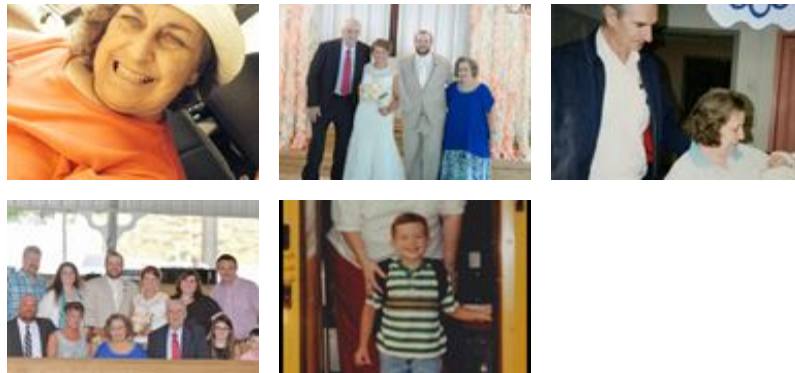
