Mrs. Nelva Garrett Roop, 89, formerly of Bowdon, Ga died peacefully Wednesday, March 13, 2024, at the home of her son and daughter-in-law, Craig and Cindy Roop in Commerce, Ga.

Mrs. Roop was born April 5, 1934, in Bowdon, Ga. and was preceded in death by her parents, J.R. and Elma Garrett, husband, David Roop and youngest son, Keith Roop. She is survived by 3 younger brothers, Doyle, and his wife Margaret of Carrollton, Roy, and his wife Lumis of Bowdon and Randy of Atlanta.

She was an excellent, competitive athlete, mixed double champion tennis player with brother Randy, Master Bridge player, loved golf with husband David. Nelva was entrepreneur and hustler, running local theatre in Bowdon with husband, pioneer multilevel marketer, kindergarten teacher at home for 30 years teaching up to 50- 5 yrs. old, part owner in local florist, primary broker in R & R Realty, helping hundreds of area residents and prolific landlord. Nelva loved Bowdon and others, entertaining and hosting was a passion. Her home at 400 Ellenwood Drive was always alive with guests at

pool parties or water aerobics, tennis matches, invited or spontaneous, various parties and events. She was a catalyst for Bowdon Athletic Booster club in late sixties, Bowdon festivals and celebrations. Her love for the community was expressed in the routine delivery of homemade bread and tireless development and contribution to the Historical Society. Nelva loved her family. She especially took pride in raising 3 active, unpredictable boys for many of the early years. She was an active member of Bowdon First Methodist Church. Family gatherings were a priority, whether it was for the Roop, Garrett or Heard families. Grandchildren were always welcome. Everyone knew the love between David and Nelva was deep.

Funeral services will be held on Saturday, March 16, 2024 at 2:00 p.m. at Bowdon First Methodist Church. Following the services, entombment will be held at Community Gardens Cemetery.

Prior to the services on Saturday, the family will receive friends at the church from 12:00 p.m. till the funeral hour.

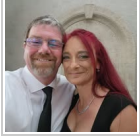
