Mrs. Norma Ezell Whitman Hammond, 83, of Carrollton went home to be with the Lord on Tuesday, March 22nd following an extended illness. She was born August 7, 1932 in Carrollton, Georgia to the late Edward Whitman and Susan Tilley Handley Whitman. Though she never finished high school because she left public education to help on the family farm, she was never afraid of hard work.

She is survived by her husband, Winford Lewis Hammond, of nearly 64 years; daughter Becky Jane and Mark Dixon of Carrollton; daughter Melanie Kay and Bob Noah of Carrollton; grandchildren Joshua Mark Dixon and Sammantha of Carrollton, Heather Michelle Carden and Will of Villa Rica, Aleigha Jane Dixon and her fiancé Thomas Bush of Carrollton, Christopher Jerry (CJ) Noah of San Diego, California, William Lewis Colt Noah of Carrollton, Marlee Alaina Noah of Carrollton; great grandchildren Kason Joe Dixon and Tucker Charles Dixon of Carrollton, and Ella Kate Carden of Villa Rica; niece Lois Bennett. Norma was the last sibling of a family of 9 children. She is preceded in death by her parents; four brothers Lloyd (Edna), Olin (Vera), Bud (Elmer), Leon (Melba), two sisters Elzie (Hiram) Reeves and Eva (Louis) Sherrill.

Mrs. Hammond worked at Sewell Manufacturing for over 20 years before she began her own business, a daycare nursery that she ran for over 31 years,

She was a generous daycare operator, taking kids in as early as 6:00AM and some not leaving until 12:00AM. She also was generous woman because there were numerous families that owed her money that she never forced them to pay her, she was a forgiving and giving woman!

Winford and Norma stayed together through thick and thin, never once did they ever want to separate. They raised two daughters there on North Jonesville Road where Ms. Hammond added on to the house for her daycare nursery. Winford and Norma attended gospel singings through the years and two of their favorite groups were the Singing Echo's and Primitive Quartet. Before the girls were married they traveled almost every year to Daytona Beach, Florida where they met many people who became their friends. Ms. Hammond was so generous that she took Mark, Becky's fiancé and Tina Rogers, Melanie's friend and paid for everything! She and Winford were faithful to Corinth Baptist church until she broke her hip in November 2013 and subsequently became a resident of Carrollton Manor Nursing Home. Mrs. Hammond's visitation will be Friday, March 25th from 4:00PM until 8:00PM. Her funeral service will be held at Corinth Baptist Church, 79 Dot Road, Bowdon, Georgia on Saturday, March 26th at 2:00 PM. 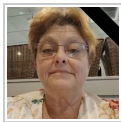

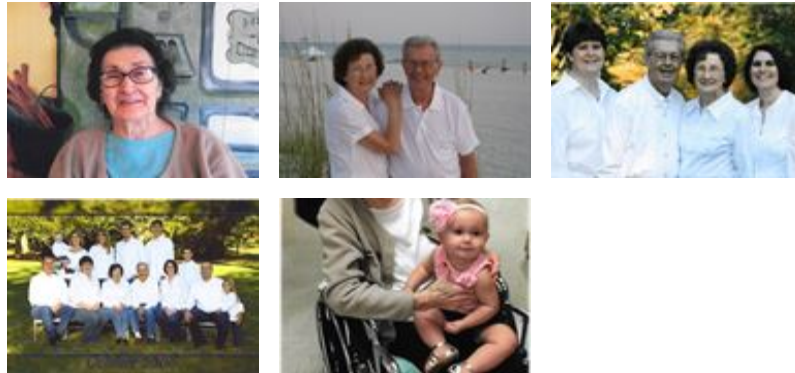

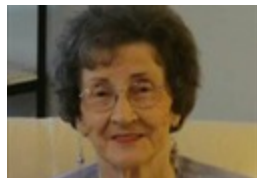
