Mrs. Ollie Mae Dixon, of Bowdon, Georgia, passed away on Tuesday, September 7, 2010. She was 95.

Mrs. Dixon was born on December 23, 1914 in Caddo Parrish, Louisiana to the late J. Claud and Maude Caldwell Roberson. She retired from Bremen-Bowdon Investment Company after more than 25 years of service. She was an active and faithful member of Bowdon First United Methodist Church. At Bowdon First, she was a member of the Wesley Helpers Sunday School Class and a member of the Susannah Wesley Circle.
