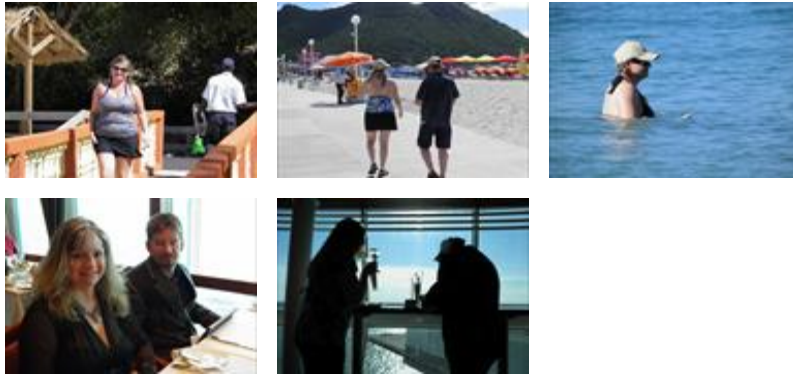

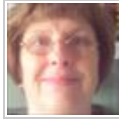

Transitioning to motherhood was especially difficult for me. I am thankful that you were there during that period of my life. Although you never wanted kids of your own, you treated mine as yours. Let me re-phrase that, you always took the Baby Bjorn and said, “Here, give him to me.” Jennings, who was never willing to go with anyone, was always excited to be carried by you. ?

Cake Decorating Class – Now those were fun times! Thanks for taking those classes with me. We had a blast learning how to decorate cakes. I’m not sure how a right-handed person, such as yourself, became a lefty when decorating cakes. ? And, I think we ate more frosting than we used for the cakes. Well, perhaps that was just me who ate all the frosting. Nonetheless, I will always think of you when decorating cakes!

Parties at your house – You and Greg sure knew how to throw parties. Although I was the DD (Designated Driver) most of the time (either pregnant or nursing), they were fun parties. You always made me feel comfortable if I had to go off somewhere to feed my child! I believe people still talk about those Olsen parties! I especially loved the Halloween parties! I got to see my husband let loose a time or two!

Jordan's Colicky phase – To this day, I still tell people about my lovely friend, Pam, who offered respite during our 2nd child's colicky phase! Seriously, I don't know how I would have made it if you wouldn't have offered to come over 4 nights a week to bounce Jordan. I was pulling my hair out! Jordan would begin crying at 5pm, but I knew that you would be there at 7pm to take over! Sometimes, that was what would help me get through the day. You had the intuition and wisdom to know that I was losing my mind! Thank you, Pam!

Yoga Training – During my post-partum period with child #2 (Jordan), I had the need to do something for myself...get certified to teach Yoga. I had no idea how I could attend the 3-day conference given that Jordan wouldn't be able to stay with anyone since he wouldn't take a bottle. You offered to go to Denver with me, care for Jordan during the day while I attended class, and bring Jordan to me when he needed to be fed. THANK YOU for that opportunity, support, care and love!

Hawaii Trip – I am so glad that you and Greg had the opportunity to go to Hawaii and that we got to share it with you both.

Trip to California for my Dad's 60th Birthday – Thank you for going with us to my Dad's 60th Bday party in northern California. It was a fun time and I am very glad that my dad and step-mom had the opportunity to meet both you and Greg.

Supporting Kids in school activities – Thank you, Pam, for your support with the Jennings' school functions. You were always his #1 fan and attended his events whenever you could. It meant the world to Jennings and us. Not having family here in Pueblo was difficult at times. But, you filled that space.

Thank you for your friendship, Pam. You were a great friend to me. I hope you felt the same.

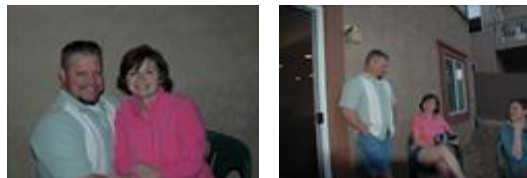
