



## Mr Parks R Warnock Jr

January 10, 1920 - July 14, 2011

Parks R. Warnock, Jr. of Bowdon, Georgia passed away on Thursday, July 14, 2011. He was 91 years old.

Mr. Warnock was born on January 10, 1920 in Atlanta, Georgia to the late Parks R. and Frances Ethel Warren Warnock. Parks was retired from Bremen Bowdon Investment Company where he was supervisor over the cutting department. He was also retired from the United States Air Force Reserve with the rank of Lt. Col. He faithfully served Bowdon Baptist Church as a Deacon, Sunday School Teacher, Church Treasure, a member of The Joy Singers, and former member of The Sanctuary Choir.
