



Rev. Ray Runyan

August 5, 1930 - November 10, 2010

Rev. Ray Runyan, of Graham, Alabama, passed away on Wednesday, November 10, 2010. He was 80.

Rev. Runyan was born in Randolph County, Alabama on August 5, 1930 to the late Sam and Missie Cospier Runyan. He retired from Sewell's Manufacturing in Bowdon after 36 years of employment and was a member of Heaton Lodge F&AM in Graham. His most important vocation, however, was that of being a Minister. Rev. Runyan preached for over 61 years and, during this time, served at 15 churches in the east Alabama and west Georgia area.

In addition to his parents, Rev. Runyan was preceded in death by his brother, Crawford Runyan.

Survivors include his loving wife, Charlotte Williams Runyan; his children and their spouses, David and Liz Runyan, Susan and Al Chandler, and Raeann and John Collier; his granddaughter, Angelina Mindrup; his brother and sister-in-law, Alfred and Rachel Runyan; his sisters, Katherine Luick and Glenda Simpson; his sisters-in-law, Ora Belle Robinson, Georgia Mae Lowery, and Shirley Baker; and his brothers-in-law, Luna Williams and Herman Williams.

Funeral services will be held on Sunday, November 14, 2010 at 3:00 p.m. (Georgia Time) at Bethlehem Campground United Methodist Church. Rev.

Ridley Herren and Rev. Chris Mitchell will officiate. Pallbearers will be Dale Lowery, Gerry Runyan, Mike Runyan, Ken Runyan, Steven Williams, and Paul Simpson. Interment will follow in the church cemetery.

Prior to the services, Rev. Runyan's body will lie-in-state from 2:00 p.m. until the funeral hour.
