



Mr. Robert "Bob" Anderson Sr.

November 25, 1918 - August 15, 2010

Robert Lee "Mr. Bob" Anderson, Sr., of Carrollton, Georgia, met his Lord and Savior on Sunday, August 15, 2010. He was 91.

Mr. Anderson was born on November 25, 1918 in Carroll County, Georgia to the late George W. and Lula Belle Eason Anderson. Mr. Anderson grew up knowing the value of hard work and carried the lessons he learned at an early age throughout his life. He was a jack-of-all-trades. During World War II, in addition to being in the Army Reserves, he was a lead machinist at Bell Aircraft Corporation, which would become Lockheed, and devised modifications to aircraft engines that extended their flight range. He was a builder who built houses for sale and to rent. He owned and operated two different stores as well as a garage and gas station. Mr. Anderson also worked at times as a jailer for Carroll County, as a bus driver, and farmed his own land and raised cattle. His work with cattle also included working at the Carroll County Livestock Sales Barn. Mr. Anderson was a devoted Christian and was a member of Antioch Baptist Church. He enjoyed bluegrass gospel music, traveling, and sports, especially baseball and the Atlanta Braves. While at Bell Aircraft, Mr. Anderson played on their semi-pro baseball team and took pleasure in the fact that his team once beat the Atlanta Crackers at Ponce De Leon field. Most of all, Mr. Anderson loved his family and will be remembered by them as a loving father and friend.

In addition to his parents, Mr. Anderson was preceded in death by his wife, Nell Robinson Anderson; his son, Bobby Lee Anderson, his daughter, Letsey Lee Hatch, his brothers, Bernard, James and Joe Anderson; and his sister, Lavada Bradley.

Survivors include his daughter, Ann Anderson, and many nieces and nephews, family and friends.

Funeral services for Mr. Bob Anderson will be held on Wednesday, August 18, 2010 at 2:00 p.m. at Antioch Baptist Church. Rev. Tony McManus, Rev. James Galloway, and Rev. Donald Voyles will officiate. Larry Bradley, Kenneth Bradley, Jim Anderson, Ron Anderson, Tim Anderson, Mike Austin, and Keith Webb will serve as pallbearers. Members of Antioch's Senior Men's Sunday School Class will serve as honorary pallbearers. Entombment will follow the funeral services with Rev. H.T. Henderson conducting the interment services.

Prior to the funeral services, Mr. Anderson's body will lie-in-state at the church from 1:00 p.m. until the funeral hour.
