Mr. Robert "Bob" E. Thompson, of Bowdon Georgia passed away Tuesday, July 1, 2014. He was 84.

Mr. Thompson was born in Pulaski, Virginia to the late Cordele and Augusta Bell Dunn Thompson. He was a World War II veteran of the Marine Corps, a member of Salem Baptist Church and the Masonic Lodge. He enjoyed gospel singing and performed for The Evangelights and The Gospelights. By trade he was an electrician and worked with Local Union 613.
