



Mr. Sherman Anthony Leon Lowery

June 10, 1943 - March 11, 2026

Mr. Sherman Lowery, of Bowdon, Georgia, passed away peacefully on March 11, 2026, at the age of 82.

Born on June 10, 1943, in Bowdon, Sherman was the son of the late John Henry and Vertie Lee Williams Lowery. A hardworking man who took great pride in providing for his family and serving his community, Sherman spent many years working as a security guard for the Villa Rica Housing Authority before retiring.

Sherman was also a familiar face in the Bowdon community through the businesses he owned and operated. Over the years, he ran the Stateline Skating Rink and Sherman's Store, places where many friends and neighbors gathered and made memories. Later, he and his beloved wife, Deborah, opened a restaurant together, continuing his tradition of bringing people together.

A proud veteran, Sherman honorably served his country in the United States Army and completed two tours in Vietnam. His service was a source of deep pride and reflected the strength and dedication that defined his life.

More than anything, Sherman treasured his family. He was a devoted husband, father, grandfather, and great-grandfather whose love, guidance,

and steady presence meant the world to those who knew him.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his son, Michael Lowery; his sisters, Glenda Baughn and Linda McLeod; his brother, Ken Lowery; and his niece, Kim Baughn.

He leaves behind many who will cherish his memory, including his loving wife, Deborah Lowery; his children, Cheryl Moore (Robert) and Mark Lowery (Teena); his brothers, Jimmy Lowery (Jeanette) and Stanley Lowery (Lounell); his sister, Jeanette Brook; seven grandchildren; and eight great-grandchildren.

Funeral services for Mr. Sherman Lowery will be held on Sunday, March 15, 2026, at 3:00 p.m., with Bro. Mike Sprayberry officiating. The family will receive friends prior to the service from 1:00 p.m. until the funeral hour.

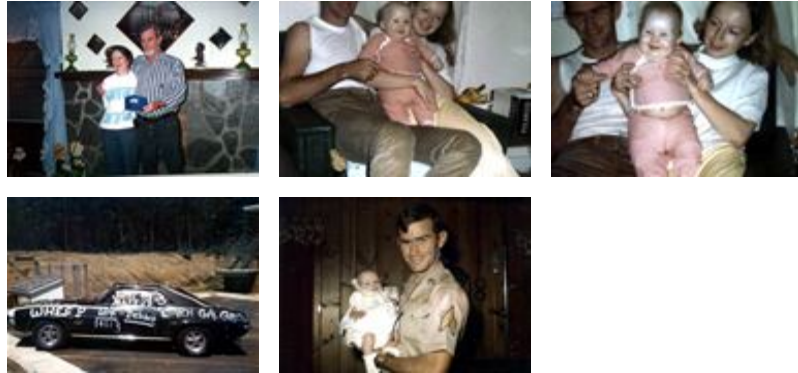
