Mr. John Silven Gibbs, of Ranburne, Alabama, passed away on May 24, 2012. He was 87.

Mr. Gibbs was born on December 29, 1924 in Cleburne County, Alabama to the late John Edmond and Myrtie Truett Gibbs. He was a veteran of the U.S. Army and retired from the Cleburne County Board of Education where he worked as a bus driver and custodian. He also was a lifelong farmer and raised cattle and hogs.
