Miss Taylor Brooke McKee, of Roopville, Georgia, passed away on Friday, May 27, 2011 from injuries sustained in an automobile accident. She was 16.

Taylor was born on October 20, 1994 in Carrollton, Georgia to Barry McKee and the late Tammy McKee. She was a student at Central High School where she was involved in many activities including the Fellowship of Christian Athletes. She had also attended school in Heard County and, while there, enjoyed the FFA, especially the construction program. Taylor was very active in the youth department at her church, Ridgeway Baptist, and was one of the featured singers in the youth choir. She loved life and had made many, many friends.

She was preceded in death by her mother, Tammy McKee, and a close friend, Mallory Crawford.
