Mr. Benjamin Thomas “Tommy” Jones, of Ranburne, Alabama, passed away on January 29, 2018. He was 68.

Mr. Jones was born on June 4, 1949 in Bowdon, Georgia to the late Howard and Louise Smith Jones. He was a mechanical engineer and was retired from Amaco Fabrics and Fibers and the Douglas County Water and Sewer Authority. Mr. Jones served on the Cleburne County Board of Education, the Ranburne City Council, and was a member of the Gideons in Cleburne County. He was a dedicated member of Ranburne First Baptist Church where he taught Sunday School and served as a Deacon. He was a loyal servant to his community and to the Lord.
