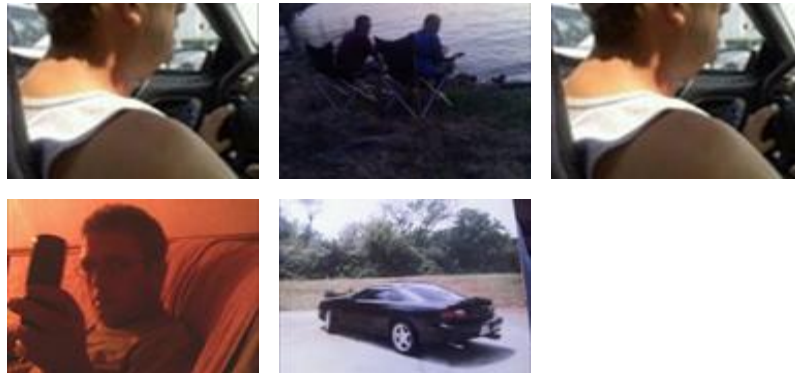
tony use to call mr just to see how everything was going with me and we would end up talking for about an hour or so about everything.
